The Associate Dean leads our college's student services team and works to enhance the student experience, support student recruitment, transition, and success, and foster a sense of student identity with the college and the university.

The Associate Dean of Student Affairs faces challenges and opportunities unique to the largest direct-entry college on campus with the greatest programmatic breadth. In addition to being the college of destination for students pursuing Arts & Science degrees, Arts & Science delivers academic programming to the vast majority of undergraduate students on campus and serves as a starting point for students seeking admission to professional colleges.

A PhD and/or terminal degree with a proven track record in teaching and success in managing a large program is required. Recent experience working to support the needs of a diverse undergraduate student body would be an asset. Demonstrated success in leading people to achieve exemplary performance and outcomes is essential. A high level of proficiency in personal effectiveness and relationship building competencies is vital.

This position is intended to begin either 1 January 2023 or 1 July 2023 and is classified as an out-of-scope administrative position with an initial term of five years, with the possibility of renewal.
